

Custom Video Gallery Plugin - Customer User Guide

This guide explains all menus, settings, display locations, and layout controls available in the Custom Video Gallery plugin.

1. Admin Dashboard Menu Structure

After activating the plugin, a new Custom Post Type called 'Videos' appears in the WordPress admin panel.

Videos Menu

- All Videos – View and manage all uploaded videos.
- Add New – Add a new video.
- Video Categories – Manage video categories.
- Settings – Plugin configuration panel (Video Gallery Settings).

2. Video Gallery Settings Page

Navigate to: Videos → Settings

This page contains multiple tabs:

General Tab

- Brand Logo
- Default Mode (Light/Dark)
- Subscribers Display
- Header Menu Toggle
- Font Family
- Posts Per Page

Membership & Razorpay Tab

- Razorpay Key ID
- Razorpay Key Secret
- Membership Currency
- Membership Plans (Label, Duration, Price)

Email Settings Tab

- From Name

- From Email Address
- Email Subject Prefix

Gallery & Display Tab

- Gallery Order By
- Gallery Order (ASC/DESC)
- Grid Gap
- Container Padding
- Border Radius
- Button Radius
- Shadow Level
- Primary Color
- Background & Card Colors

3. Display Location - CVG Header Menu

The plugin includes a toggle option to enable or disable the Header Menu.

If enabled, you can assign the menu in:

Appearance → Menus → Manage Locations → CVG Header Menu

Assign your desired WordPress menu to this location.

4. Templates Included

- single-video.php – Controls single video page layout.
- cvg-fullscreen-template.php – Fullscreen video layout template.
- search-video.php – Video search results template.

5. Making Single Video Pages Full Width

Method 1:

Use the 'cvg-fullscreen-template.php' template if your theme allows template selection.

Edit the video post and choose the Fullscreen template if available.

Method 2:

Go to Appearance → Customize → Custom Post Types → Single Videos

Set Layout to Full Width (if your theme supports it).

Method 3 (Advanced):

Override the template in your theme by copying single-video.php into your theme folder and modifying layout classes.

6. Automatically Created Pages

On plugin activation, these pages are automatically created:

- Custom Login – [cvg_login]
- Forgot Password – [cvg_forgot_password]
- Sign Up – [cvg_signup]

You can edit these pages like normal WordPress pages.

7. Additional Features

- AJAX functionality
- Razorpay payment integration
- User authentication system (Signup/Login/Dashboard)
- Dark Mode support
- Hover previews
- Comments & Author support
- REST API enabled
